_____ is scheduled to have a dental procedure under anesthesia today. Like you, our greatest concern is his or her well-being. Here at Broad River Animal Hospital we use the safest anesthetics currently available. Your pet's vital signs will be monitored throughout the procedure with state of the art monitoring equipment and by our technical staff.

Prior to anesthesia we will perform a complete physical examination to identify any existing medical conditions that could complicate the procedure and compromise the health of your pet. Because there is always the possibility that a physical exam will not identify all of your pet's health problems, we will also perform a comprehensive pre-anesthetic blood profile (if not previously performed) prior to anesthesia. While a pre-anesthetic blood profile does not guarantee the absence of complications, it will greatly reduce the risk and identify medical conditions that require additional precautions.

The most accurate assessment of your pet's dental health can only be achieved while your pet is under anesthesia. With a thorough, comprehensive oral exam, we may find that your pet may need teeth extracted. While we always try to preserve teeth whenever possible, many times we need to extract diseased teeth to enhance your pet's overall general health as well as to provide relief from dental pain. Prior to extracting any teeth, we will assess them with dental x-rays. Before any teeth are extracted, however, we need your permission to do so.

** If you choose this option, **it is extremely important** that we be able to contact you while your pet is under anesthesia. Please provide us with home, work and cellular phone numbers in the space below.

**** If we cannot contact you, we will x-ray and extract teeth as needed.**

We recommend a dental sealant called OraVet. It is applied weekly to help prevent tartar build-up. We apply the Oravet sealant after a routine cleaning and you can follow up with the prevention gel once weekly at home.

This is a good time to consider the **Home Again Chip**. It is easily administered while your pet is under anesthesia. The \$79.99 cost includes the cost of the chip, registration and 1 years annual membership. (\$16.99)
